## Signing up to Collins ebooks


To access Collins eBooks you will first need to register and login to the eBooks platform.

1. Type [www.collins.co.uk/ebooks](http://www.collins.co.uk/ebooks) into your browser
2. Click “Access your ebooks” button



### 3. Sign-up to the Collins ebook service

You will need to create an account in order to redeem your ebook. Click “Sign Up” in the registration form below.




You will be sent an email to the email address you used when you registered your account. Please click on the link included in the email.

Once you have successfully signed in you will see your library of books “My Bookshelf”. Until you redeem a book there will be no books available.




## Adding an ebook to your bookshelf


If the book you purchased has an activation code on the inside cover of the book please use the method described below.

### From printed code


1. Next to your name at the top right of the screen there is a 'Get your eBook' drop down menu.



2. Click on the arrow – this will reveal a text box.



3. Type your Access Code into this box and Click "Submit". (The code can be found on the inside cover of your printed book.)  
You should now see your book in "My Bookshelf".



4. If you get a message saying your code is invalid, please follow the steps below.


